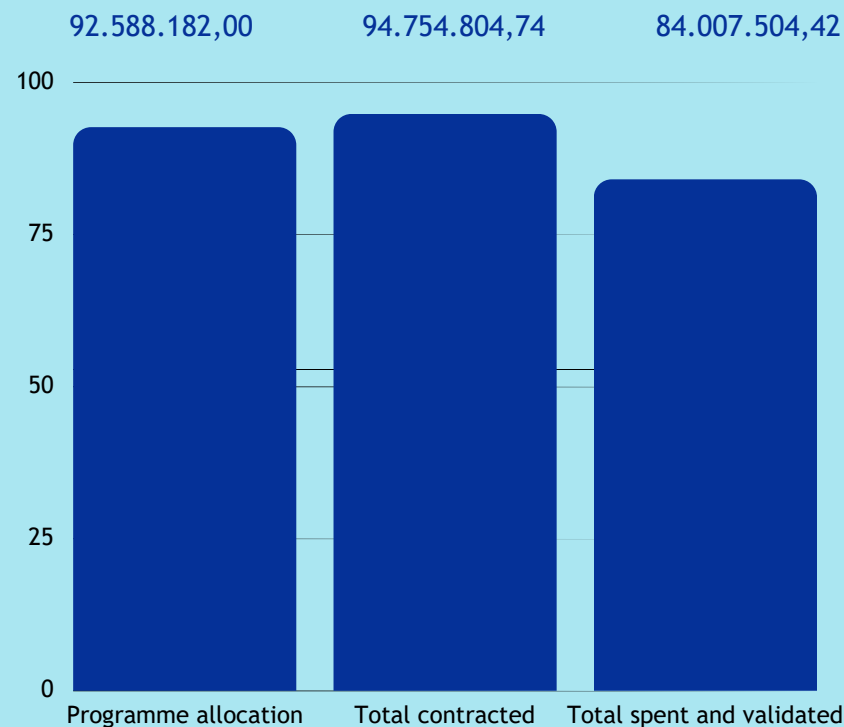


The financed projects have consolidated mature crossborder partnership experiences, strengthened the cohesion of Programme area contributing to removal of obstacles to cooperation in all sectors and benefitting the whole community while disseminating best practices at EU level well beyond borders of the area.

In total:

7 calls (standard n. 1-2-3-4/2016; strategic n. 5-6/2018, standard n. 7/2019, Integrated Territorial Investment - I.T.I. - 2017) and 2 Pilot Actions; 63 projects for a total of 367 beneficiaries (included technical assistance).

Total contracted funds € 94.754.804,74 (European Regional Development Fund - ERDF € 79.664.817,67) - 102,8% of which spent and validated € 84.007.504,42 (ERDF € 70.841.696,08) - 88,7%.

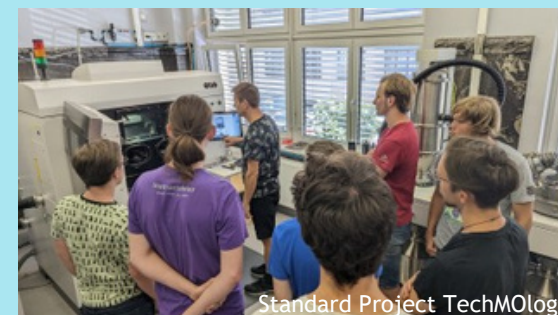

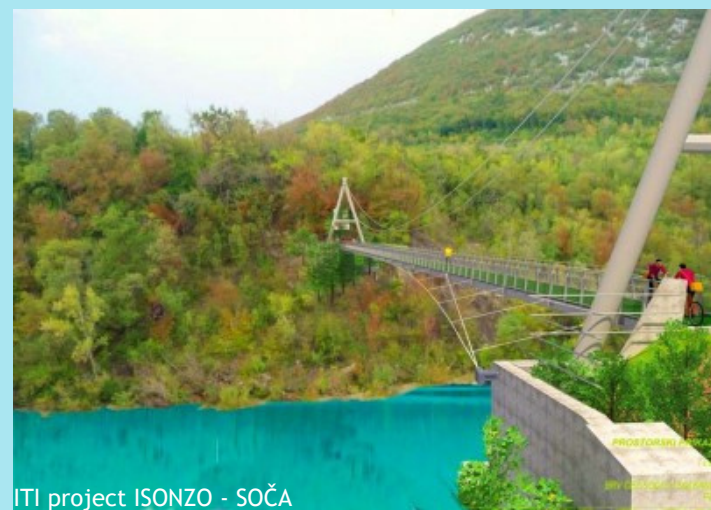

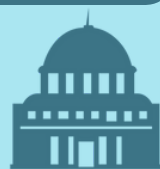

- Communication: in May, the Programme Annual Event 2022 (61 attendees in Caorle) was dedicated to Green perspectives for Interreg Italy-Slovenia.
- In September, the EC Day focused on “Discover European projects and future opportunities” with 337 attendees. It launched the new 21-27 Programme while giving space to 14-20 projects.
- In October, a workshop was promoted at the European Week of Regions and Cities (43 attendees) on “Crossborder pilot actions to boost innovation in the health system through data sharing”.
- Interreg Volunteer Youth - IVY: the Programme hosted 2 IVY volunteers who actively contributed to an enormous increase in the implementation of Programme social channels (Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, YouTube and LinkedIn since August 2022).
