



#### Criterion B9 - compulsory requirements on indicators

#### Assessment manual - section 4.2.1.

IP	Compulsory minimum requirement
1b	Each project shall contribute to the achievement of the OUTPUT indicator CO26 by involving as project partner enterprises and/or consortium of enterprises, cooperating with research institutions.
ID	The minimum requirement to be met is that each project shall mandatory involve as project partners at least two enterprises or a consortium of enterprises composed of at least 2 enterprises directly involved in project activities.
( 4	The minimum requirement to be met is the following: "each project shall mandatory contribute to the achievement of at least two of the addressed indicators. Indicator 3.2.3.is mandatory for all projects".
6d	Indicator 3.2.2. is also intended to be crosscutting to Indicator C023. In the case that pilot actions are implemented on the Natura 2000 sites, both indicators C023 and 3.2.2. are valorized.
6f	The minimum requirement to be met is the following: "each project shall mandatory contribute to the achievement of both the addressed indicators".
11 ETC	The minimum requirement to be met is the following: each project shall mandatory contribute to the achievement of at least one of the addressed indicators.

At least 2 enterprises or consortium must fulfill criteria A3, B2, B3, B6 and B7. If not, the project is rejected.

As for IPs 6d, 6f and 11ETC, during A-B check only the ticking of the indicators requested as minimum requirement is checked as knock-out criterion.

Afterwards, during quality assessment, the real correspondence of project proposal content to indicators will be carefully checked



Indicator CO23 is exclusively referred to Natura 2000 sites

Both indicators 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 refer **exclusively** to improvement of **water and waste management**

#### Compulsory minimum requirement

Each project shall contribute to the achievement of the OUTPUT indicator CO26 by involving as project partner enterprises and/or consortium of enterprises, cooperating with research institutions.

The minimum requirement to be met is that each project shall mandatory involve as project partners at least two enterprises or a consortium of enterprises composed of at least 2 enterprises directly involved in project activities.

At least n. 2
enterprises shall be
directly involved in
project activities,
individually or
aggregated,
in cooperation with
research institutions.

Individually means they have to be PPs and respect eligible criteria (A3, B2, B3, B6 and B7)

Aggregated means they can be member of an aggregation / consortia

aggregation/consortia is the PPs and has to respect all eligible criteria

Consortia in broadest sense: any enterprises networks and aggregation foreseen in legal system in Italy (ATI, RTI, Consorzio di imprese, GEIE-EGIZ) and Slovenia (GEIE-EGIZ, GIZ).

e.g.: a consortium with 10 enterprises, of which 5 are involved in project activities, only 5 counted for indicator
