

UNESCO Global Geoparks: utilizing and promoting territorial identity including geological, ecological and cultural resources as a new tool for sustainable local development mainly through **geotourism.**

UNESCO Global Geoparks: actively involve local communities and indigenous peoples as key stakeholders in the Geopark.

It is recommended that all relevant local and regional actors and authorities be represented in the management of a UNESCO Global Geopark.


