General assumption

1. The calls are in line with the Cooperation Programme
2. Four calls: 1/2006 1b; 2/2016 4e; 3/2016 3c, 3d, 3f; 4/2016 11 ETC.
3. Four calls coincide in some contents (eligible area, eligible expenses, application and evaluation procedure)
4. Four calls differ only on some paragraph (subject, typologies of applicants, financial allocation, project dimension and duration)

***conditions for additional partners**

Common features to all four calls Eligible area

- 5 Italian statistical regions (Provinces of Venice, Udine, Pordenone, Gorizia and Trieste)
- 5 Slovenian statistical regions (Primorsko-notranjska, Osrednjeslovenska, Gorenjska, Obalno-kraška and Goriška).
- Partners with either administrative competence on eligible area or a branch (no matter as it is denominated) in an eligible area are considered as eligible provided their intervention benefits the Programme area.
- Exception of participation of partners/implementation of activities outside Programme area. Conditions
- PP from outside Programme area cannot be LP

Common features to all four calls Eligible expenses

- Regulation (EU) No 481/2014:
- I. Staff costs;
- II. Office and administrative expenditures;
- III. Travel and accommodation costs;
- IV. External expertise and services costs;
- V. Equipment expenditures;
- VI. Infrastructural investments and works.
- Project costs: (start and end dates)
- Preparation costs: between 01/07/2015 and project submission.

Common features to all four calls

Beneficiary cofinancing

- 15%
- Italian Rotational Fund for public and public equivalent
- State Aid

Common features to all four calls Application procedures and deadlines

Notice of calls published on:

- the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia and

Common features to all four calls Required documents and mandatory annexes

1. LP Statement digitally signed by the legal representative of the LP;
2. PP Statement digitally signed by the legal representative of every PP;
3. Partnership Agreement, signed by the legal representative of the LP and of each PP; after the subscription of the Agreement in paper form by all the parts, the LP shall scan it and sign it digitally;
4. ONLY FOR PROJECT FORESEEING INFRASTRUCTURAL INVESTMENTS AND WORKS: any permit or authorization required, and any other document;
5. ONLY FOR PARTNERS FROM OUTSIDE THE PROGRAMME AREA: Agreement and a confirmation of the eligibility of its legal status.

Common features to all four calls

Projects assessment, ranking, and admission to funding

In line with the Cooperation Programme and with Assessment Manual

The steps of assessment procedure will be:

1. Check of administrative eligibility of Applications - by the on-line System and by the Joint Secretariat;
2. Eligibility assessment - by the Joint Secretariat;
3. Quality assessment - by external assessors;
4. State Aid assessment - by National Authorities (on limited number of projects).

Common features to all four calls Project approval

The Monitoring Committee takes the final decision on project approval and financing.

The ranking list will be presented to the Monitoring Committee together with an **Overall Evaluation Report**.

No individual notification - the final ranking of the project proposals will be published on the www.ita-slo.eu Programme website.

The entire procedure shall last **8 months** from the deadline for submitting project proposals to the Monitoring Committee approval of the final ranking list and contracting by the Managing Authority.

Language

The Call and the Application Package are published in Italian and Slovene language.

The Application Form and annexes must be submitted bilingual, in Italian and in Slovene language.
