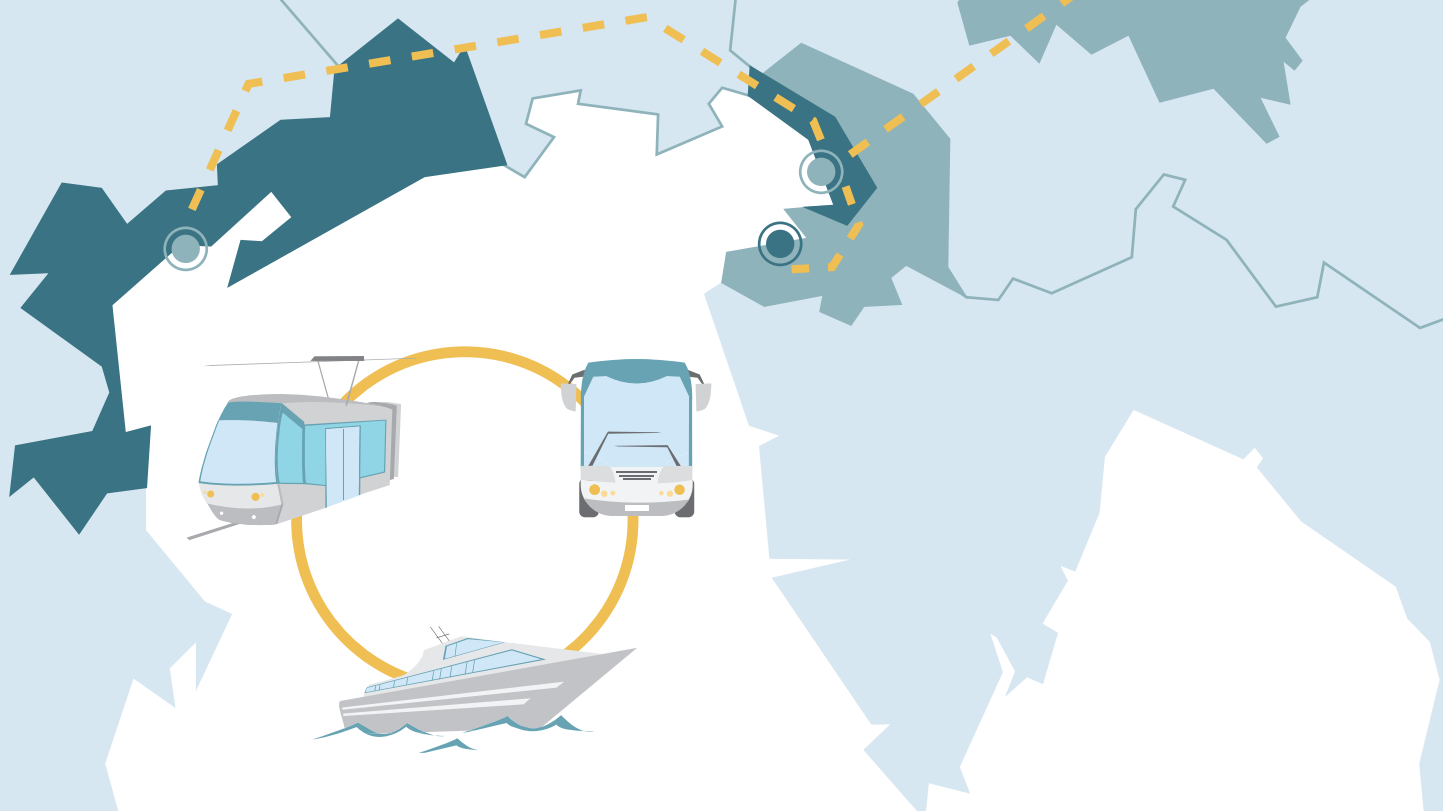

Welcome to the third edition of Newsletter series of the FORTIS project!

*FORTIS is a European project funded by Interreg V A Italy - Slovenia 2014 - 2020, that aims at identifying innovative solutions which facilitate lives of citizens of the cross-border areas. Moreover, it intends to promote institutional dialogue in two trajectories: 1) the improvement of local public transport systems with a view towards cross-border integration and facilitation of knowledge and 2) the exchange of administrative good practices related to different legislation on vehicle registration. Following a gap analysis on the areas of intervention, specific pilot actions will test experimental solutions to improve services and institutional dialogue in the area, allowing the establishment of a stable institutional cooperation network.*

### Final Conference

On 07.07.2022 took place the Final Conference of the Project FORTIS in Trieste organized by the LP and in close coordination with the PPs. The speakers discussed the project achievements in cross-border mobility and shared the knowledge in heavy vehicles checks in the cross-border area between Italy and Slovenia. Moreover, the FORTIS partners showed the results of the pilot activities performed over the last three years, as well as the main outcomes of the feasibility studies performed in the area related to integrated ticketing and cross border maritime connections. The institutional cooperation played a crucial role in delivering tangible outcomes, leading towards the drawing of three Memoranda (or MoUs) and one agreement among main players.



## Published D.3.2.2.2 Feasibility study on “Maritime passenger transport between Slovenia and Italy”

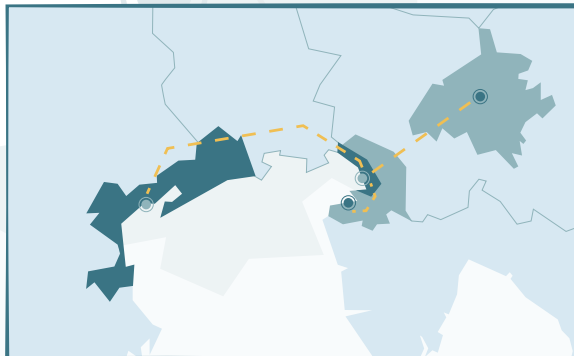
